Who is the course targeted at:

The course is targeted at anyone who wishes to gain a greater understanding of the processes involved in moving out of conflict into peace. Participants will explore issues such as justice, truth recovery, reconciliation and victim/offender complexities.

What is involved?

This course will run for 8 weeks with each session lasting 3 hours.

Requirements for course accreditation are:

Participants will be required to complete a ‘Semi Structured Journal’ which demonstrates knowledge gained in class and 2 assignments.

Successful participants will be awarded a Level 2 accreditation with the Open College Network.

Each course will have no more than 14 participants.



Course Content

- Understanding of the theories of Reconciliation
- Different types of transition and their impact on the reconciliation process.
- The factors and processes that lead to the identification of victims.
- Different types of offenders and recognise the different perspective they have on the conflict.
- Recognise that Transitional Justice is multi-faceted.
- Truth recovery and dealing with the past
